<u>Huynh Nguyen Khanh Trang (ホーチミン医科薬科大学 産婦人科医 / 2017 年 7 月 23 日 ~8 月 5 日)</u>

Japan is a country with many similarities with Vietnam. The main food is rice with green-smooth rice fields. The popular drink is tea. And even medical education has a nearly homogeneous training system, with six years of medical education after graduating from high school.

Medical training in Japan has improved 3 times in training in 50 years and recently (over 11 years) is to undertake 2 years rotation - training immediately after graduation 6 years. This training allows young graduates to perfect their basic practical skills and help them time to orient themselves to the appropriate specialty later.

The difference in the 6-year medical training program is that Japan has no direction for doctors, and Vietnam has graduated as a general practitioner.

After graduation 6 years, all doctors must join the "Junior doctor program" for 2 years in Japan. While in Vietnam, physicians now have a number of choices: the excellent group chooses a boarding test (after 3 years, becomes a specialist, with a certificate of practicing + boarding diploma + specialty) The second group is admitted to a hospital (after 18 months of practicing certificate) and the rest of the group will join 18 months program.


Therefore, in the 18 month program, it is necessary to specify in more detail: After doing 4 specializations: internal medicine + surgeon + obstetrics and gynecologist + pediatrics, what subjects will be the next 6 months?

The combination of a number of specialized hospitals in the training program is also an important point in the organization in Japan. In addition to the General Hospital has many faculties selected as today.


