

2019 7th Annual Training Course in Biomedical Innovation and Entrepreneurship



The Goal of the course is to train students to develop skills in design thinking, brainstorming, product development, and commercialization for unmet medical needs and to become more creative, innovative and savvy in translational research in the Biomedical Sciences. This is taught through lectures, group work and presentations.

Date: Sunday, 25th August – Friday, 6th September 2019 (arrive in Sydney on 24th August 2019)

Location: University of Technology Sydney
